China International Remanufacturing Forum 2011 will be held by Duxes Business Consulting inc. on April 20-21 at the Zhejiang Hotel, Hangzhou, China. The forum will examine the latest policy disclosures regarding China's remanufacturing industry and provide a platform for international remanufacturers to share development strategies, emerging trends and new technologies.

The forum is directed by China's National Development and Reform Commission and the China Academy of Engineering. These policies have enabled both rapid development of the industry and the upgrading of global remanufacturing technologies.

Keynote speakers include reman industry leaders from China, Germany, UK, the US and various international government officials, providing an in depth look at how new policies and regulations effect the global reman industry, with perspectives on policy, development and technology. Additional topics underlying the forum include: import/export licensing, automotive OEMs, electronic and mechatronics reman, joint venture opportunities and brand building.
