Cooper and Otway Basin Transaction Unconditional

Central Petroleum Limited (**ASX: CTP**) ("**Central**") refers to its ASX announcement "*Strategic expansion into the Cooper and Otway*" dated 22 December 2025 and advises that the transaction with ADZ Energy referred to in that announcement has become unconditional following all conditions precedent being satisfied. The transaction is scheduled to formally complete on 23 January 2026.
